678/11 TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

679/11 TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Cllr Blezzard declared an interest as a Member of Havenstreet Parish Council and as a member of the IWALC Executive.

680/11 MOTION TO RESCIND A PREVIOUS DECISION.

That the following resolution passed by the Sandown Town Council on the 27th June 2011 and set out in Minute 663/11 be rescinded:

“That the Clerk be given delegated authority to pay planning fees, design fees immediately and project fees upon receipt of planning permission given.”

REASON: the services have not been procured in accordance with Standing Order 76 and Financial Regulation 11.

Financial Regulation should read No 12 not 11 as it was updated in 2009.

The Mayor requested that Cllr Blezzard put forward the motion to rescind Minute 663/11 to the Council. Cllr Blezzard thanked the Mayor for calling the meeting.
