521/10 DECLARATION OF INTEREST

Members declared the following interests in matters on the Agenda:-

523/10 TO RECEIVE A REPORT FROM THE TOWN CLERK ON THE GAS SUPPLY/HEATING OF THE BROADWAY CENTRE AND MAKE A DECISION ON HEATING THE BROADWAY CENTRE.

The Clerk reported that the Broadway Centre no longer had a heating system and there was no gas supply to the buildings. She suggested to the Council that a ring main fitted as an interim measure so that the rooms could be heated with electric heaters which would only be used when the room was booked.
